Supplemental Trainings

Wood Badge - advanced training in leadership skills for all adults in BSA programs. To be eligible for an invitation to participate, the leader must be fully trained in their position and able to fully attend both weekend sessions.

Leader Roundtables - Leader roundtables are held monthly on a district basis. Boy Scout and Venture leaders can participate in a variety of specialized trainings and discussions to help provide a safe and meaningful program to their youth.
